

District 101 desires to maintain a safe school environment for all students. In recognition of the fact that certain students may have life-threatening reactions to certain foods, the Superintendent shall develop, implement, and adjust as appropriate from time to time, procedures relating to food allergy management. Such procedures will be designed to minimize/control the risks of students encountering food-related life-threatening allergic reactions as a result of food provided to them at school by the school or school-related organizations. The procedures will comply with applicable law and regulations and will be aligned with recommended guidelines of the Illinois Department of Health and the Illinois State Board of Education regarding food allergies. The procedure will be developed with consideration of student safety, parental involvement/cooperation, clarity, simplicity, and ease of implementation and enforcement. The procedures will also include a communication plan designed to inform all appropriate stakeholders of the procedures in effect from time to time.
